Option A: Tongariro River Rafting – Whio trip

In 2.5 hours you navigate over 60 heart-pounding, roller coaster rapids with an expert guide at the helm. Throughout the trip you'll be treated to sights only accessed by raft. If you're looking for things to do in Taupo, book with us and enjoy the spectacular unspoilt wilderness and adrenalin-pumping action! Check the predator traps set to protect whio and do your bit to help save them. End the trip with a hot soak in the Tokaanu Hot Pools. Bring swimsuit & towel. www.trr.co.nz

Option C: Wairakei Tourist Park

30-minute jet boat ride with **Hukafalls Jet**. Combine 360° spins and passing nature by incredibly close at disorientating speeds for an amazing must-do visitor experience whilst in Taupo, before even reaching the awe inspiring majesty that is the Huka Falls. From the unique vantage point on the jet boat you have the best water level view of Huka Falls – New Zealand's most visited natural attraction. <u>www.hukafallsjet.com</u>

Guided Tour of **Huka Prawn Park** - On the banks of the beautiful Waikato River, just minutes from Taupo towncentre, you will find the iconic and unique family playground, of Huka Prawn Park. Soak in the **Wairakei Terraces Thermal Pools** - At Wairakei Terraces, pools of varying temperatures between have been strategically positioned below the silica terraces and waterfall, taking full advantage of the geothermal water flow that is drawn to the earth's surface from 1.5 kilometres underground. You are also welcome to take a walk through the geothermal park. Bring swimsuit/towel. <u>www.wairaketerraces.co.nz</u>

Option D: Private Lake Taupo Fishing Charter

3hr lake charter with **Chris Jolly Outdoors** - Most fishing takes the form of trolling either lures or flies (no bait fishing is permitted). We use a combination of downriggers, harling and trolling on board – depending on the time of day, weather and client time restraints. Option E: Great Lake Trail – Orakau to Kawakawa

The trail is an 11km, grade 3 ride with a well-drained surface, making it suitable for those with moderate fitness levels or beginners looking to progress. The track will also be really enjoyable for more experienced riders who will be able to take advantage of some free flowing sections.
